Neil Allen Van Pelt, 24, of Richmond died Wednesday, June 16, 2010. He was born May 28, 1986 in Lynchburg, VA to Rev. Barry Neil and Martha Feagan Van Pelt.

Neil was a 2004 graduate of Culpeper County High School and later graduated from Virginia Tech with a BS in Biology in 2008. He was currently in his 3rd year at Virginia Commonwealth University where he was studying to become a doctor of Pharmacology. He was a member of Phi Delta Chi Professional Pharmacy Fraternity and of the Rho Chi Honor Society. Neil was strong in his Christian faith and was Baptist by denomination. He will be remembered as a wonderful son, brother, and friend and will be greatly missed by all who knew him.

In addition to his parents, he is survived by his siblings, Jeremy Van Pelt and his wife, Jinli of Culpeper, Catherine Van Pelt of Richardsville, and Christie El-Nemr and her husband, Khaled of Richardsville, his paternal grandmother, Eileen Van Pelt of Mt. 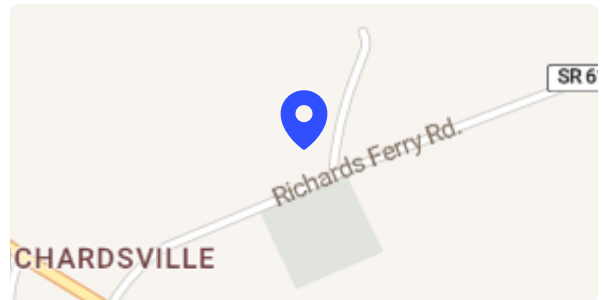

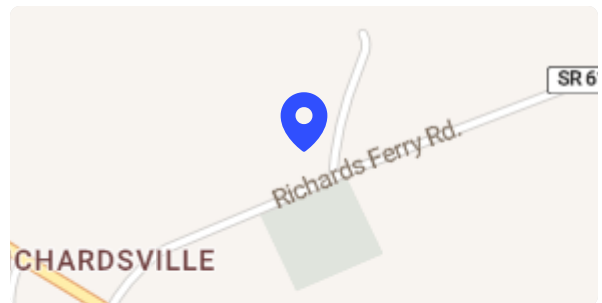

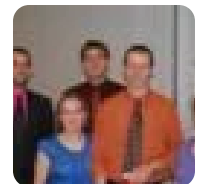
