She was preceded in death by her parents, Robert and Irma Jefferson; a sister, Virginia Bruner

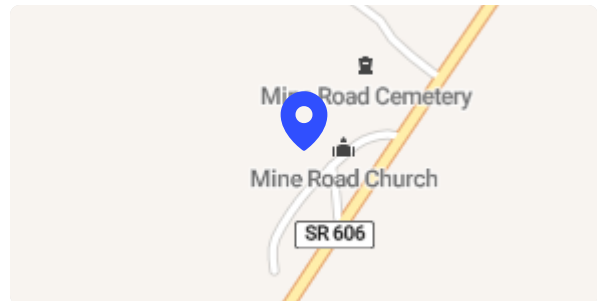

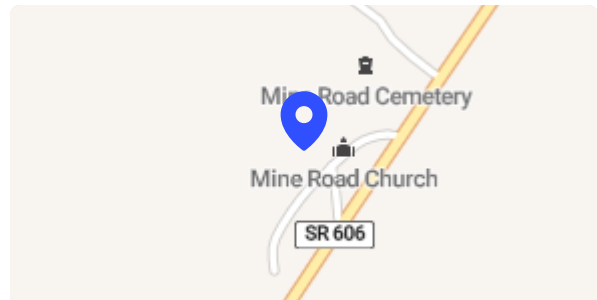

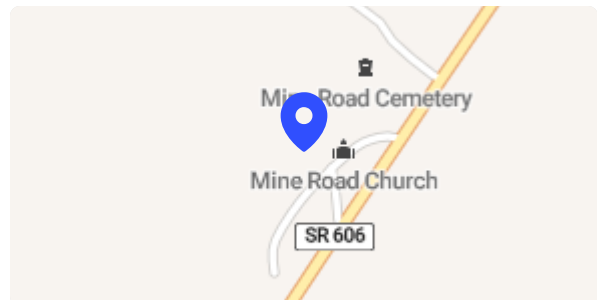
