Edwin Ingle Reeves, Jr., 78, of Culpeper died Sunday, December 12, 2010. He was born May 19, 1932 in Washington, D.C. to the late Edwin Ingle and Margaret Parsons Reeves.

Ed had a passion for people, printing, collecting trains and antiques. With his daughter Bonnie Gill, they established and opened the Minuteman Mini Mall in 1992 on Route 3 in Culpeper. Before the opening of the mall, Ed worked in the printing industry for over 40 years. He was a loyal member of the Masonic Lodge in Culpeper, Madison and Orange, yet traveled to various lodges in the surrounding areas. 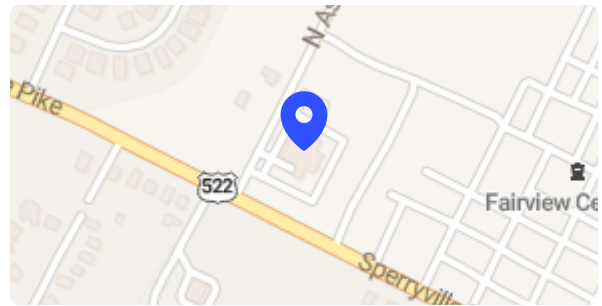

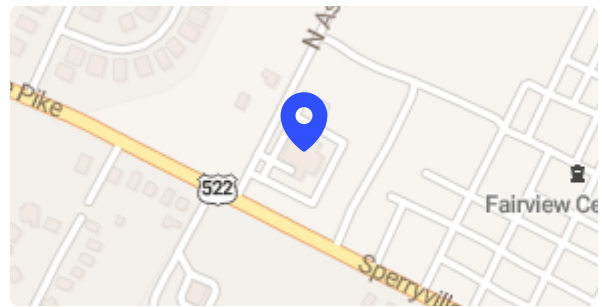
