Clarence Russell Corbin, 84, of Reva died Wednesday, December 29, 2010 at Culpeper Regional Hospital. He was born October 15, 1926 in Sperryville to the late Albert Clark and Laura Woodward Corbin.

Mr. Corbin attended Wolftown Pentecostal Church, was a former Mason of the Barboursville Lodge and a member of the Ranger Infantry Companies (Airborne) of the Korean War.

He is survived by his wife, Janet K. Corbin, four children, Joyce Santamaria of Port St. Lucie, FL, Joseph Wayne Corbin of Enterprise, AL, Susan K. 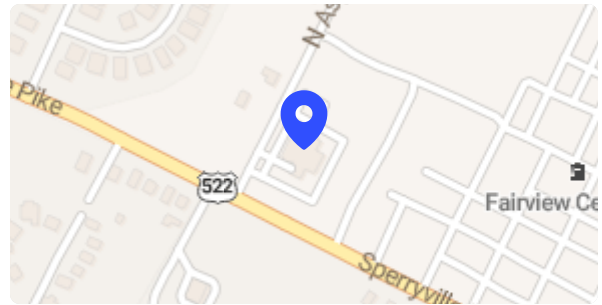
