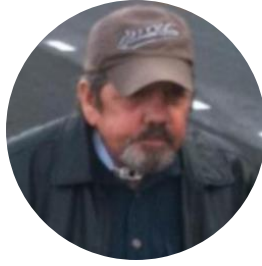

Joe Young, age 59, of Manassas, passed away on Tuesday, March 29, 2011.

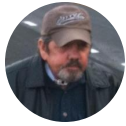
