Lillie Mae Johnson, 72, of Woodville died Wednesday, April 27, 2011 at Fauquier Hospital. She was born May 11, 1938 in Rappahannock County to the late Oscar and Josie Corbin Wharton.

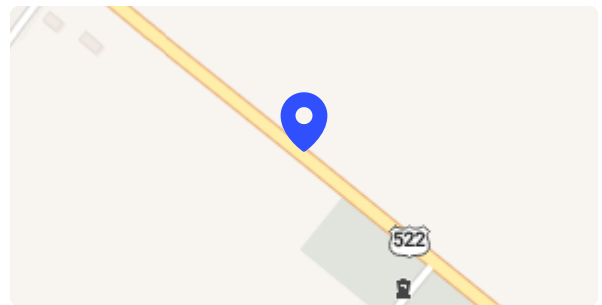
