Althea L. Pohle Cree, 92, of Fredericksburg died Friday, April 29, 2011, at her home.

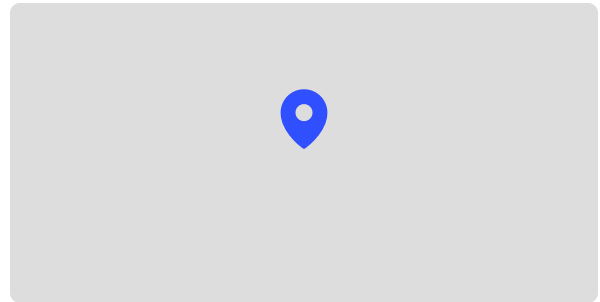

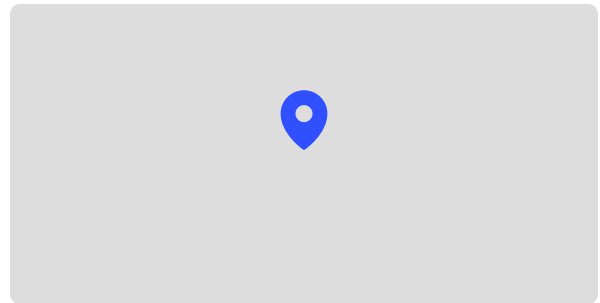

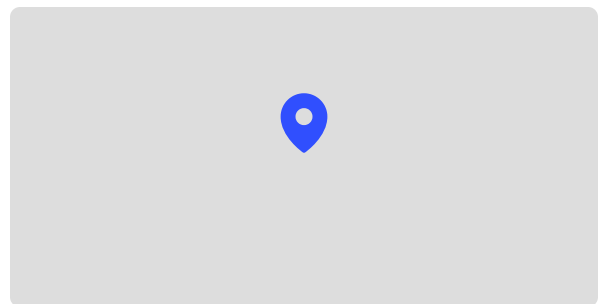
