Bonnie L. Wright, 98, passed away Saturday, January 10, 2015 at her home in Dogwood Village Senior Living in Orange, Virginia. She was born in Overbrook, Oklahoma on August 11, 1916 to Rilly and James Thomas Barnes.

Fifth in a family of ten children, she grew to adulthood in farming communities in southwestern Oklahoma during the difficult times of the Dust Bowl and the Great Depression. 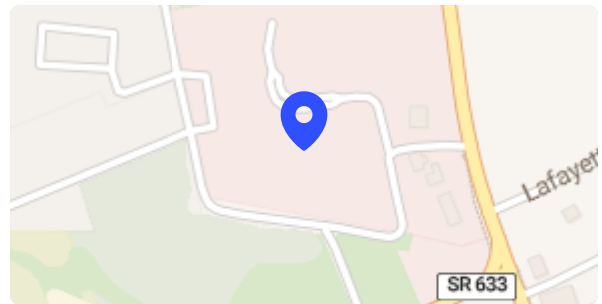
