Alouise Friedman, 89, of Culpeper went home to be with her Lord on Monday, January 26, 2015. She was born April 12, 1925 at Sibley Hospital in Washington, DC to the late Susie Lee Durham Snellings Friedman and Albert Julius Friedman. She worked for the British Ministry of Supply from 1943-1946. Miss Friedman went to work for Sessions and Caminita a prominent public relations firm from 1946-1964. She then worked for the Department of Housing and Urban Development as a management analyst for the office of budget until her retirement in 1995. Found and Sons Funeral Chapel of Culpeper is serving the family.

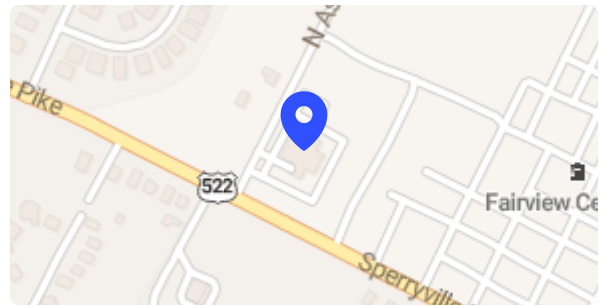

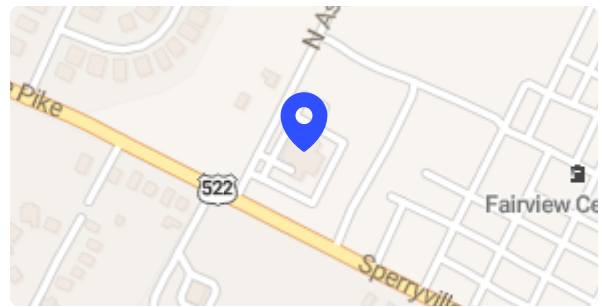

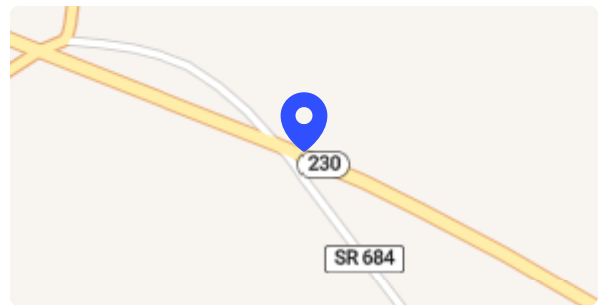
