# James Arthur Rose

**J**ames A. Rose, 63, of Spotsylvania County, lost his courageous fight with cancer on Saturday, August 20, 2011 at his home.

Jim served in the US Coast Guard from 1965 until 1968. He worked and retired from Moore Business Forms in 1990 and later retired from the Spotsylvania Schools Maintenance Department in 2008 where he worked as an HVAC mechanic.

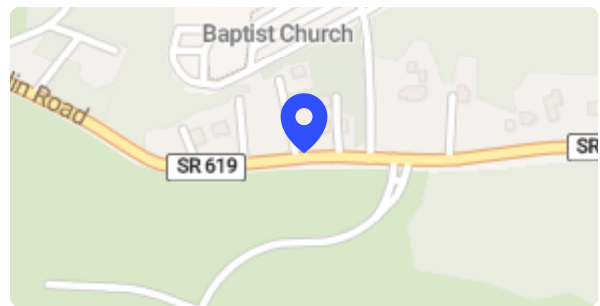

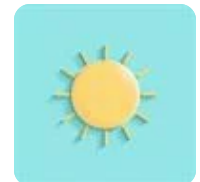
