Glen Wilbert Eaton, 98, passed away Tuesday, July 7, 2015, at Woodmont Healthcare Center in Fredericksburg.

Mr. Eaton loved taking care of his yard, being outside, cars, NASCAR races and going to McDonald's. He was a retired electrician for Riddleberger Brothers of Harrisonburg.

Glen was born June 23, 1917, in Broadway, and was a son of the late Casper W. and Annie E. (Dove) Eaton.

In November 1992, he married Shirley Cohoon, who preceded him in death on Aug. 23, 2014. Mr. Eaton was also preceded in death by a son, Boyd Lee Eaton; three brothers, Claude Eaton, John Eaton and Forest Eaton; and two sisters, Mae Eaton and Pearl Rollins.

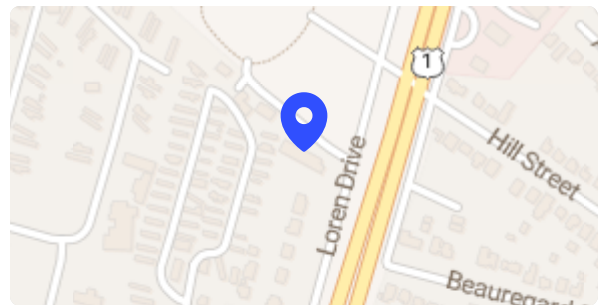

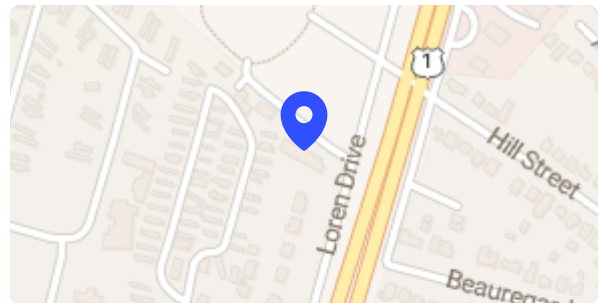
