**S**tanley Steven (Skip) Czajkowski, Sr., 67, of Spotsylvania County passed away Thursday, September 22, 2011 at his home with him family which meant the world to him.

Skip was a volunteer fire fighter in New York for many years. He was a lifetime member of the Spotsylvania County Rescue Squad, Boy Scout leader and a R. L. 2 for a year in Spotsylvania.

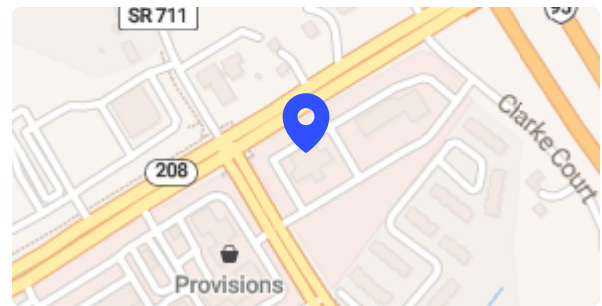

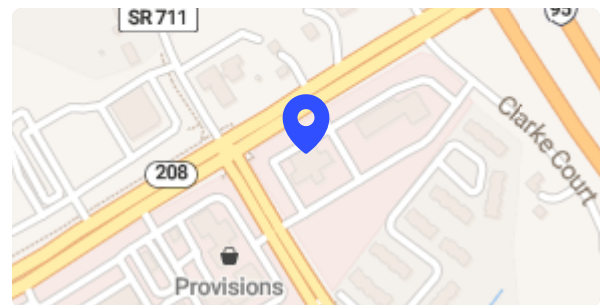
