## Virginia Lee Hitt

Virginia Lee Hitt, 88, of Culpeper died Tuesday, August 4, 2015, at Oak Springs of Warrenton, with her daughters by her side.

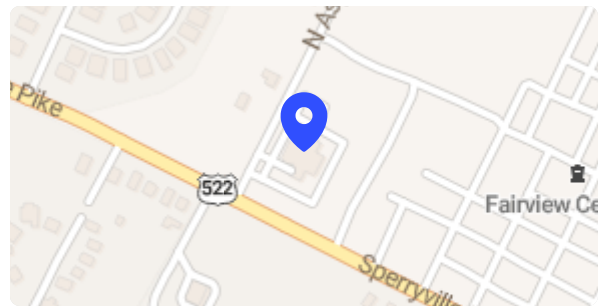

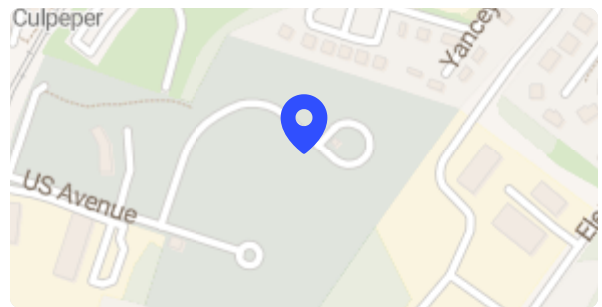
