Juliette was educated in the New York public schools, she attended LaGuardia Community College and Phoenix University. During her early years Julie had a passion for dancing where she studied ballet and Jazz dance. Julie also had a passion for the theatre, she appeared in the off Broadway play Clever Jack and other off Broadway productions. In the 1980's she was a featured solo dancer in the Macy's Thanksgiving Parade. Julie was raised in Davis Temple Church of God In Christ under Bishop John H. Davis where she received salvation and was baptized and filled with the Holy Spirit.

Julie married in 1982 to Brian D Medley Sr. and from this union was born 4 children, Evrin, Carla, Brian and Jayda Medley. In June 2015 she remarried Nimrod Robinson. 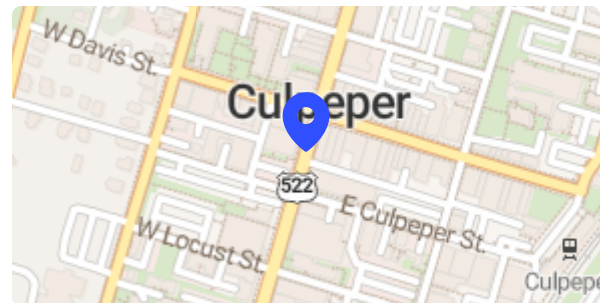

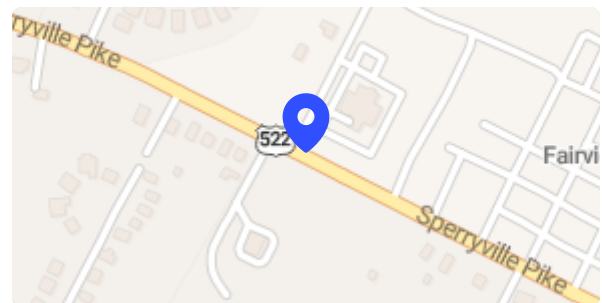
