Found and Sons Funeral Chapel of Culpeper is serving the family.



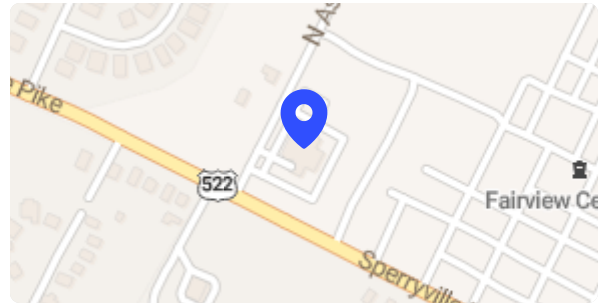

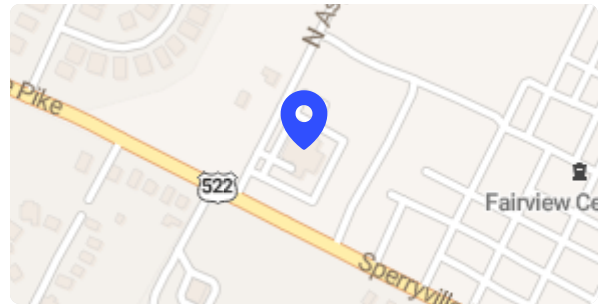

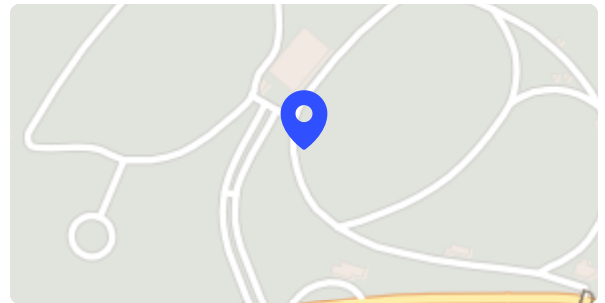
