Inurnment will be private.

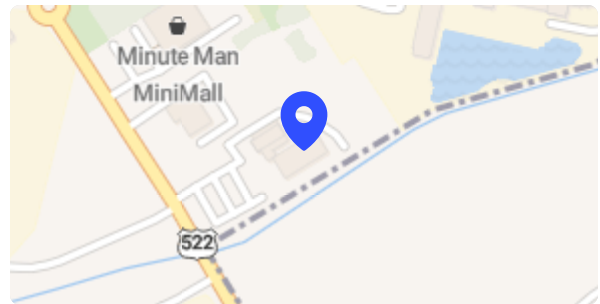

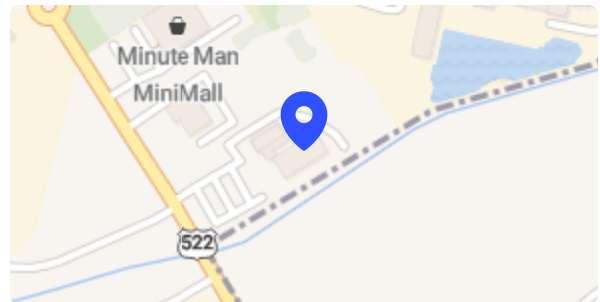
