Edna Cornelia Metzinger, 91, of Sperryville died Sunday, April 29, 2018 at Autumn Care of Madison. She was born December 24, 1926 in Kensington, MD to the late Benjamin Rogers and Cornelia Emily Hughes.

Mrs. Metzinger was a member of Sperryville United Methodist Church, Culpeper Minuteman Chapter NSDAR, Colonial Dames, and United Daughters of the Confederacy-Black Horse Chapter. She loved gardening and was a former member of the Rappahannock Garden Club.

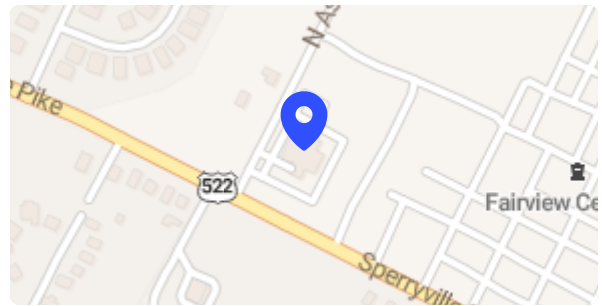

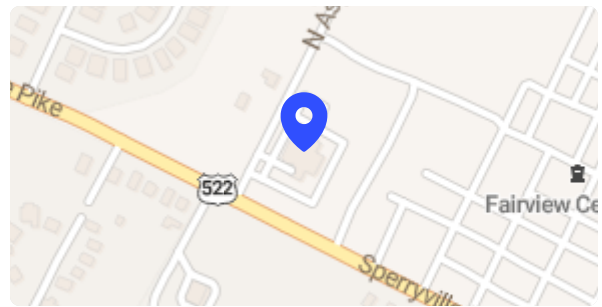

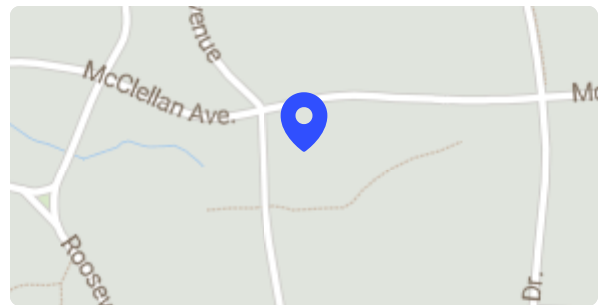
