Elizabeth "Jake" Farrar Cassidy, 97, of Culpeper died Thursday, May 3, 2018 at her residence. She was born January 21, 1921 in Fluvanna, VA to the late William and Arlene Wright Farrar.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband of 60 years, Robert L. Cassidy, MD; and daughter-in-law, Cathay Cassidy.

Mrs. Cassidy was a member of Culpeper United Methodist Church, Calfee Garden Club, and the Culpeper Country Club. She was also a member of the Culpeper Hospital Pink Ladies and the Alma Bragg Methodist Church Ladies Group.
