Marshall M. Martin, 69, of Unionville, passed away peacefully at his home with his wife by his side, on Monday, June 18, 2018.

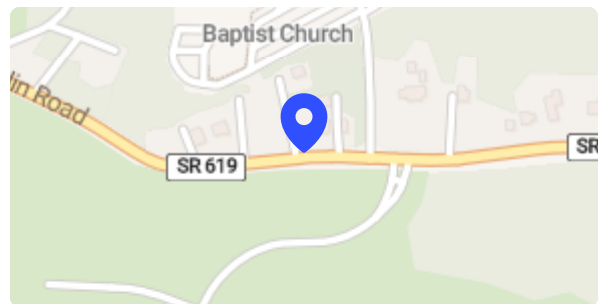
