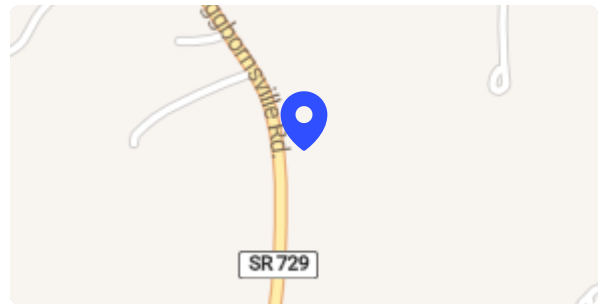

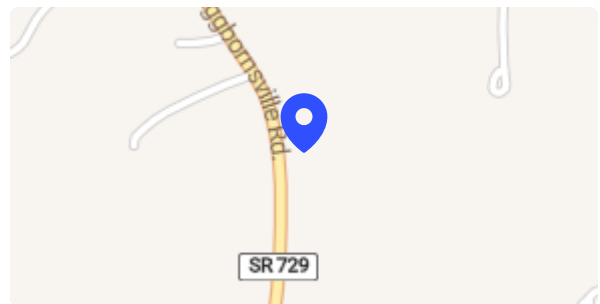

Eventually Reves decided to come to work at the WH partially because we had so much overtime there. From the beginning we both commuted to work with our forman in his very small truck that wasn't suited to three people. Every friday we would be stuck in heavy traffic and one of the local radio stations played the same song each week at the same time. It was Todd Rundgren's song, "I Want to Bang on the Drum All Day". If you aren't familiar with it, the hook line is " I don't wanna work, I just want to bang on the drum all day". It pumped us up for the weekend. Reves and I both "danced" in our seats like we were choreographed, using our arms and exaggerated upper body movements. We hooped it up knowing it was probably a little aggravating to our boss. I had hoped to see Reves before he passed but, I waited too long. Since Janice said he was having some bad days and he might not remember me, I had planned to play that song for him on my phone through some portable speakers. I just know that would have perked him up and he might well remember it. God rest his soul.
