She married her sweetheart, Ralph L. White on March 14, 1964. They were happily married for 54 years. From this union, they were blessed with eight children that she truly loved and adored.

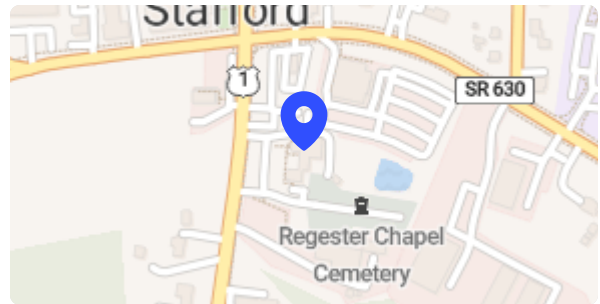

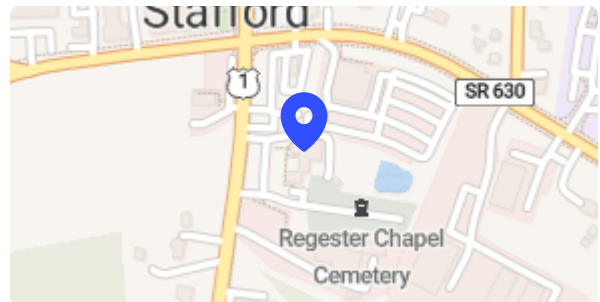

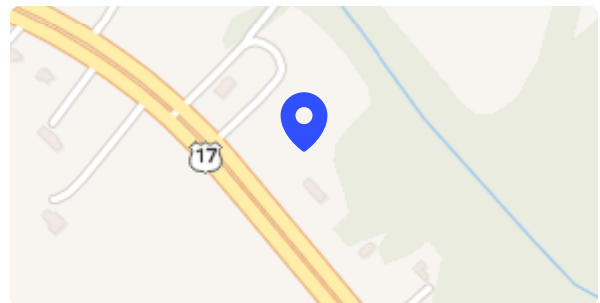
