Robert Charles Cleer, 84, of Orange, VA died Thursday, December 27, 2018 at his residence. He was born February 5, 1934 in Arlington, VA to the late Thomas and Beulah Morrison Cleer.

Mr. Cleer was a veteran of the US Navy having served during the Korean War on a submarine called the USS Trumpetfish from 1951 to 1955. 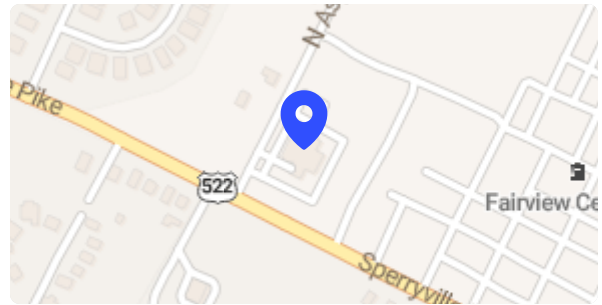
