Wilmer Lee Hartman, 76, of Stanardsville died Wednesday, February 13, 2019 at Martha Jefferson Hospital after a short battle with lung cancer. He was born March 30, 1942 in Romney, WV to the late Wilbert Hartman, Sr. and Mary Strawderman Hartman.

Mr. Hartman owned and operated "Ultimate Drywall" for almost 25 years. He was an avid NASCAR and Redskins fan and absolutely loved Johnny Cash and Elvis Presley. He is survived by four children, William E. Hartman of Buffalo, NY, Lynda C .Hartman of Culpeper, Wilson E. Hartman of Stanardsville, and Melissa A.
