Betty Jean Atkins Myers, 67, of Elkwood died Monday, July 22, 2019 at the University of Virginia Medical Center. She was born August 2, 1951 in Warren County to the late Lyle and Barbara Atkins.

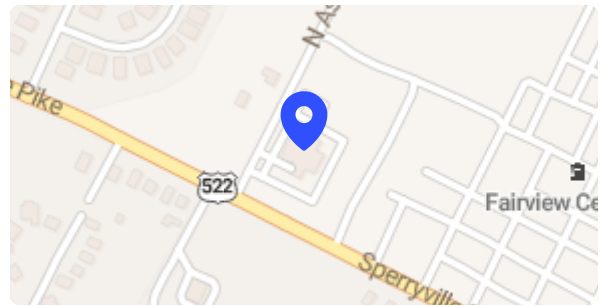

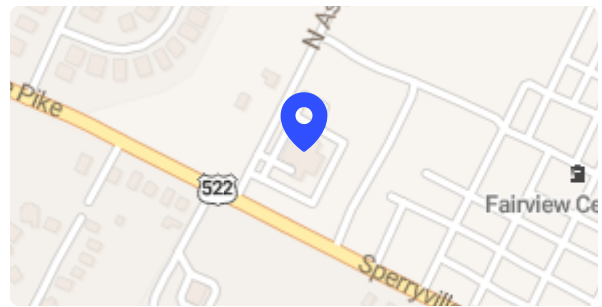

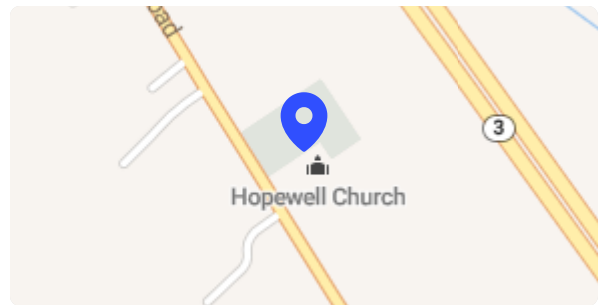

We cried, we laughed and I had made her day by calling. One of Betty's favorite songs was "You Make Me Smile" by Uncle Kracker. She would sing that song at the office every time it came on the radio.
