Forrest Andrew McCormick, 69, of Culpeper died Tuesday, October 22, 2019 at VCU Medical Center from complications of Agent Orange. He was born December 14, 1949 in Youngstown, OH to the late Fred and Faye Richards McCormick.

Mr. McCormick was a veteran of the US Army having served during Vietnam and was stationed in Korea.

He is survived by his wife of 43 years, Dorothy; sons, Shayne McCormick, Paul Jenkins and Matthew Jenkins and his wife, Jessica; daughters, Tracy Skotis, Donna Essad and Vanessa Cooper; and 16 grandchildren, Carmela, Harley, Bruce, Klarisa, LeAnna, Alaina, Ashley, Matthew Thomas, Emanuel, Robert, J.C., Joshua, Chris, Ashleigh, Devin and Nadia. 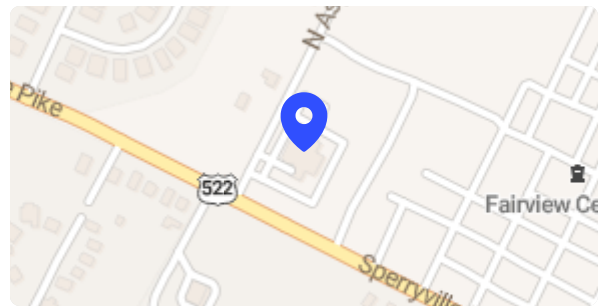

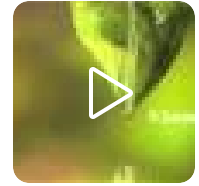
