**C**hristopher Allen Guest, 35, of Culpeper died Monday, October 28, 2019 at INOVA Fairfax Hospital. He was born October 7, 1984 in Arlington to Ray Godwin and the late Lisa Guest.

Chris was a poet whose words will forever echo in our hearts. He attended Arlington county public schools where he pitched on the baseball team.

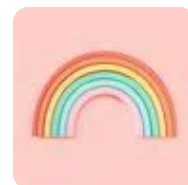
