David Eugene Yowell, Sr., 83, passed away on December 9, 2019 at Culpeper Health and Rehabilitation Center in Culpeper, VA. 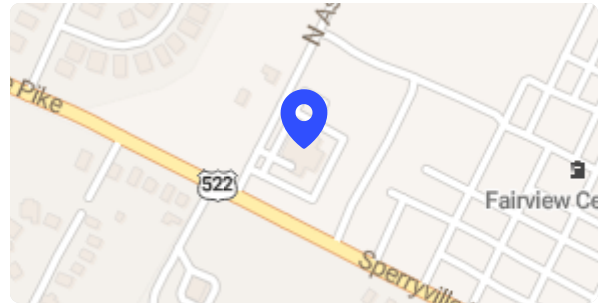

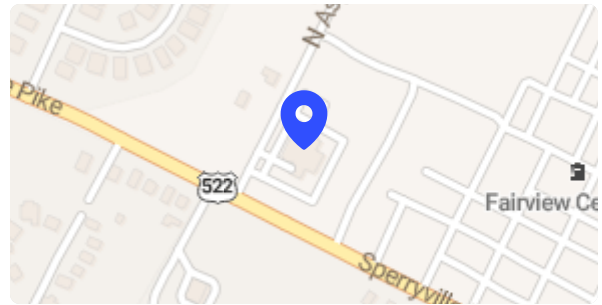
