Ruby Virginia Morley, 70, of Fredericksburg, departed this life on Monday, September 3, at her home, with her family by her side.

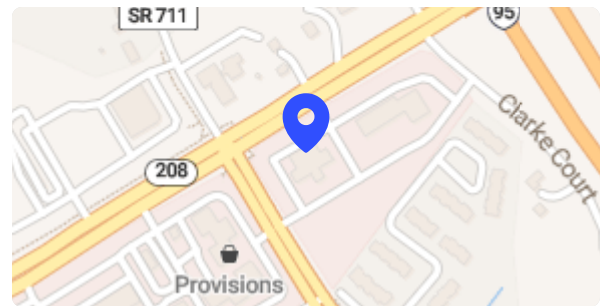

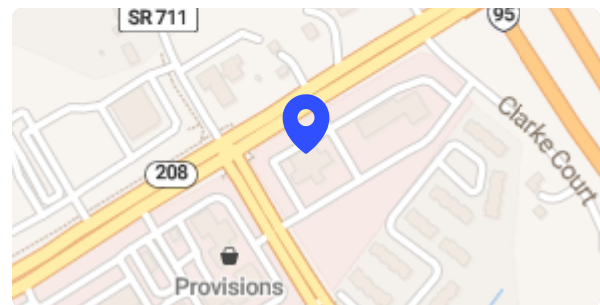
