Rev. Robert Powell Lacy, 84, of Manassas, formerly of Brandy Station, passed away on June 22, 2020 at the Adler Center for Caring. He was born April 25, 1936 in Brandy Station, VA, the last surviving child of 17 children born to the late Archie and Essie Moody Lacy.

Rev. Lacy was a veteran having served in the U. S. Air Force. He was ordained in 2005 and a member of Shiloh Baptist Church and Wayland Blue Ridge Baptist Association Ministers and Deacons Union. He enjoyed cooking, playing his guitar and was a diehard Redskins fan.

He is survived by his wife of 40 years, Carole Lacy; three children, Michael Lacy, Gwendolyn Bryant, and Glenn Lacy (Colette); two stepchildren, Robert W. Richards, Jr., and Vanessa Richards; five grandchildren and four great grandchildren; seven step grandchildren and eight great step grandchildren; and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins and other relatives and friends.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by one son, Timothy Lacy; one stepdaughter, Robin I. Richards; and his 16 siblings.






