Charlie Davis Hawkins, 73, of Castleton, died Monday, March 1, 2021 at his home. He was born June 7, 1947 in Rappahannock county to the late James and Elizabeth Hawkins.

Charlie was the most hard working man, who started at just the age of 7 for a nickel a day. He was a farmer with an internal alarm clock, who started his day with the sun. He wouldn't have it any other way! He loved being on his farm and will be laid to rest there, where he can always be at home.
