Carolyn D. Wright, 90, passed unexpectedly on December 13, 2021 at Mary Washington Hospital in Fredericksburg, VA. She was born December 10, 1931 to the late John and Myrtle DuPriest in Portsmouth, Virginia.

Carolyn graduated from Craddock High School in Craddock, VA and she attended William and Mary College. She met James R. Woodrow and they were married on April 21, 1950. She worked for the Virginia Department of Revenue in Fairfax City and Loudoun County where she retired. After her retirement, she and James worked together to create a building and contracting business. The couple retired from Loudon County to Charles Town, WV where she continued to live after her husband passed away.

She was very active in her church and found so much pleasure in Civil War re-enactment, square dancing, involvement in the Kiwanis Club and so many other hobbies. 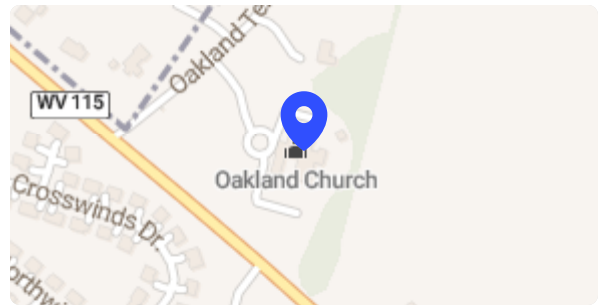

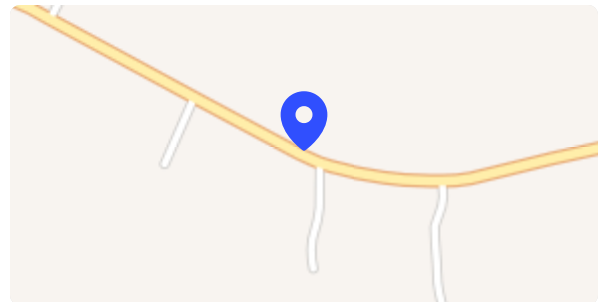

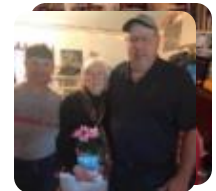
