She was an active member of her community, a past member of the Fredericksburg Woman's Club. She was a member of Gamma Upsilon and Xi Beta Chi chapters of the Sigma Phi Sorority where she held many positions including past President. As a life member of the Ladies Auxiliary of the Fredericksburg Elk's Lodge #875, she served as a past President and a member of the Board of Trustees. During her life she traveled extensively, and was fondly known to her family and friends as Engelbert Humperdinck's biggest fan.

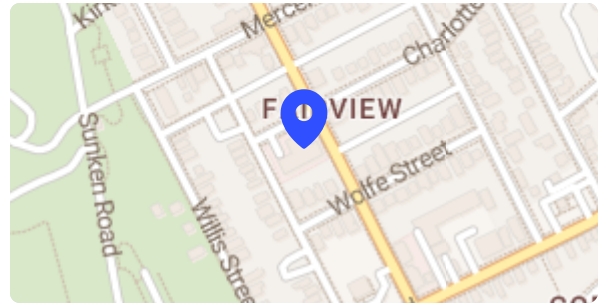

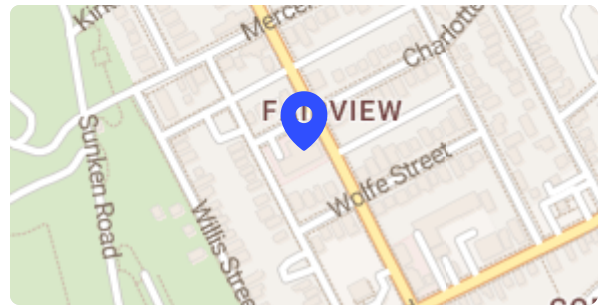
