**R**obert (Bob) John Franey, Jr. of Washington, VA died peacefully in Manassas, VA on Tuesday, June 13, 2023. Bob was born in 1943 in Philadelphia, PA to parents, Nancy C. Tucker and Robert Franey, Sr.

He attended Washington-Lee High School in Arlington, VA and later graduated from Macalester College in St. Paul, MN. He spent his early career working for Pakistan Airlines and enjoyed traveling around the world. He later found success as a technical recruiter in Fairfax, VA and retired in 2008.

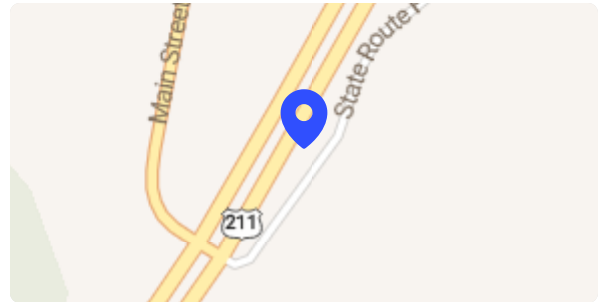

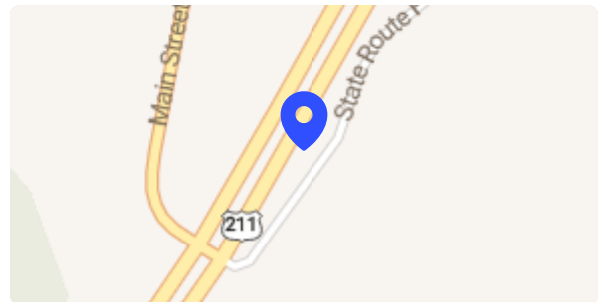

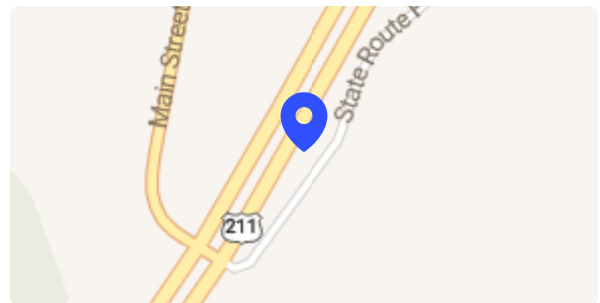
