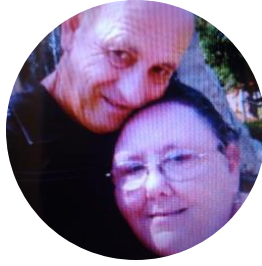

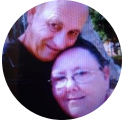

A graveside service will be held at 2:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 5, 2023 in Sunset Memorial Gardens.

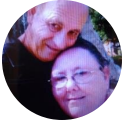
