Albert "Sam" Samuel Orrison, Jr., 76, of Castleton, died Wednesday, September 13, 2023 at his home. He was born November 5, 1946 in Warrenton to the late Albert S. and Charlotte J. Orrison.

Sam was an electrician for more than 40 years with the IBEW Local 26. He was a veteran of the US Army and served in Vietnam. Sam enjoyed working outside and on his cars. He loved NASCAR, John Deere tractors, and watching and attending tractor pulls.

He is survived by his wife of 49 years, Dorothy "Dottie" Orrison; three children, Kim Fairfax (Neal), Glen Orrison (Stacey), and Rob Orrison (Jamie); nine grandchildren, Aaron Orrison, Brady Orrison, Cody Fairfax, Sammy Fairfax, Ethan Fairfax, Carter Orrison, Grayson Orrison, Michael Martin, and Joshua Martin; one brother, Thomas Orrison (Bonnie); one sister-in-law, Sharon Orrison; and his two breakfast buddies, Mike Buckley and Roger Hitt.

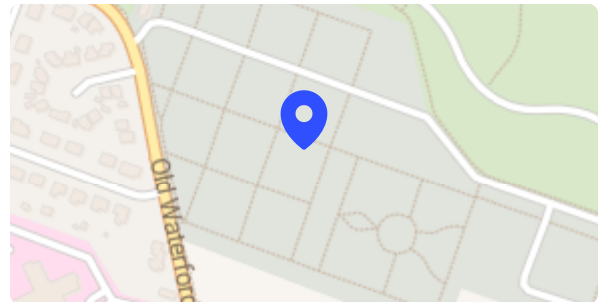

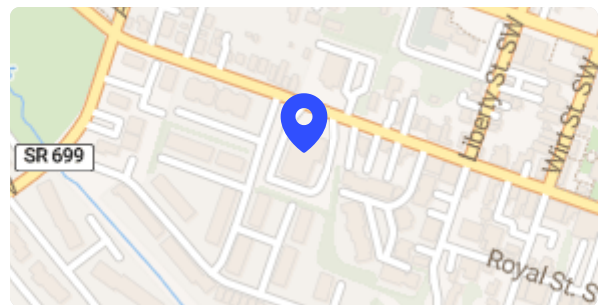
