Tommy Gray Livengood, 65, of Culpeper, Virginia died Thursday, January 25, 2024. Tommy was born in Winston Salem, North Carolina on July 6, 1958.

He joined the US Navy in 1976 and proudly served aboard the Ballistic Missile Submarines: USS Henry Clay, USS George Bancroft, USS Nathan Hale and the USS Simon Bolivar until his retirement in 1996.

Tommy was a man who enthusiastically loved; be it his family, his friends, singing and writing music, racing cars, playing pool, his cats and his Corgi, Gizmo. 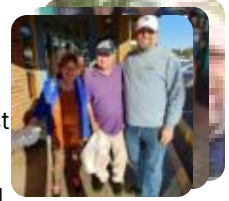

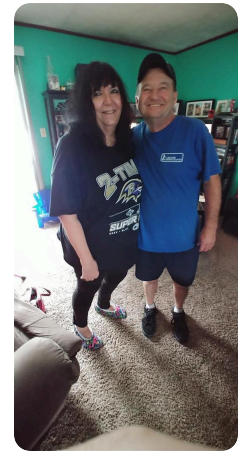
