TDS was his last job before he retired. The ones that didn't go to work elsewhere or at least not on his crew anymore. He was never politically correct he got in trouble more than once with the Safety guys or HR. 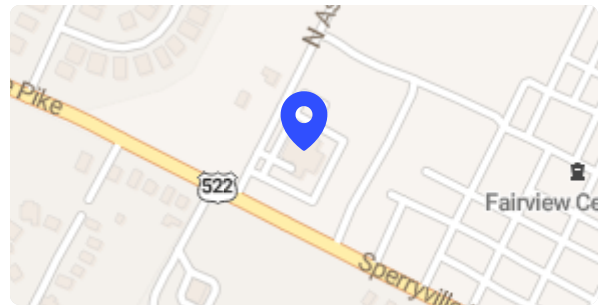

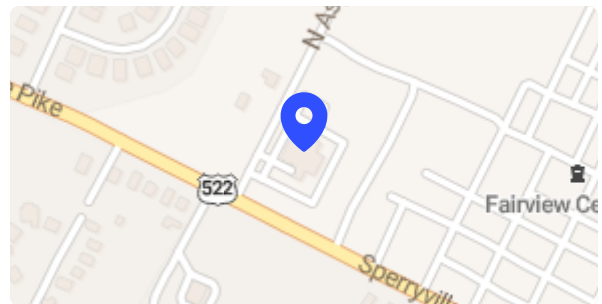
