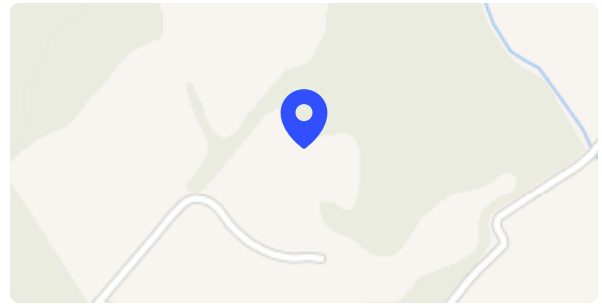

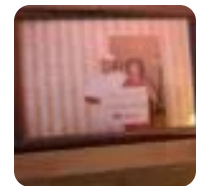
Amanda Malamphy posted:
