Stacey Celia Wilson Blankenship, 51, of Fredericksburg, Virginia passed away peacefully on July 16, 2024, at Mary Washington Hospital.

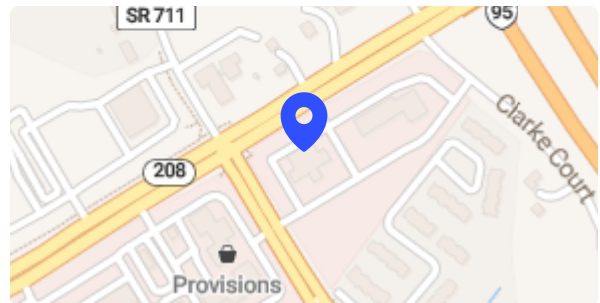

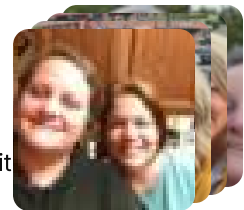
