AUG 27, 1957 - AUG 29, 2024

Courtney Campbell, 67, of Indianapolis, passed away on August 29, 2024 at his home and is reunited in heaven with his Lord.

Court was born in Indianapolis, Indiana and graduated from Warren High School. He earned his bachelor's degree from Indiana University and his law degree from DePaul University. Court dedicated 22 years of his life to the Navy. He was proud to be one of the first reservists to become an intelligence officer. Court continued to dedicate his life to others by practicing immigration law. Most of his cases were asylum-related and he loved to help others with their complicated situations. In his spare time, he loved to read books, hike, travel, and spend time with his family. He had recently moved to Spotsylvania, Virginia in May of 2024. Court was described many times as a sweet, gentle man. Most of all, he was a loving father, husband, grandfather, and a devout Christian.

He is survived by his loving wife of 35 years, Eunju Campbell; his children, Angela Campbell (Aaron Misera) and Andrew Campbell (Yoonha); a granddaughter, Louie Misera; a sister, Carla Higgs (Paul); and a nephew, Collin Higgs.

The family will receive friends from 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm on Saturday, September 7, 2024 at Found and Sons Funeral Chapel, 10719 Courthouse Road, Fredericksburg. A funeral service will begin at 3:00 p.m. in the funeral home chapel. Interment will take place at a later date at Arlington National Cemetery.

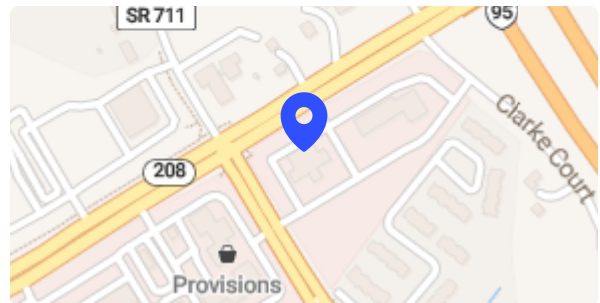

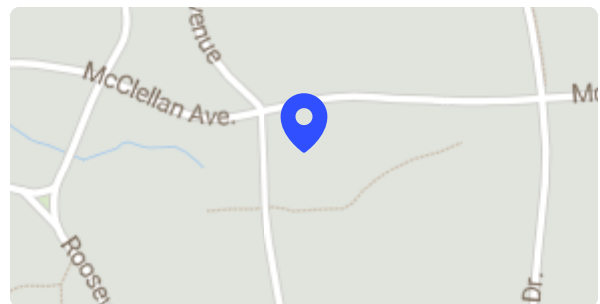

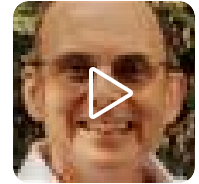

I have a few memories and thoughts I'd like to share of Mr. Campbell:1. This is one of my first few memories of Mr. Campbell: I remember being at Korean School (language school backed by the church we both used to attend) and seeing Mr. Campbell with the 1st or 2nd graders. They had to give a speech on some sort of topic for a competition, but I can't remember what exactly. I do remember him introducing himself, but, ultimately, I remember being utterly confused on why a white adult man was attending a KOREAN language school. The demographic was mostly Korean children wanting to, but mostly being forced to attend, learn Korean in hopes of carrying on the culture. I remember all the kids erupting in laughter as they heard him say the word "salami", which was Mr. Campbell's way of pronouncing the Korean word for "person" (sah-rahm-ee). Not going to lie, I laughed at it, you would too. Sure it was funny, but there were a few stronger emotions and thoughts that were running in my head during his speech that I had. Respect: I respected his effort to learn the language of his wife's culture and you could really tell that he had put forth some serious effort in putting a speech together in a foreign language. Sincerity: the effort to dive into his family's culture and to try to understand it, immerse himself in it, wasn't something I saw often. Awe: I didn't know many people attempt to learn Korean that weren't Korean so someone outside of the culture learning the language was so shocking to me. Throughout the years I'd randomly think back to my time in the language school and he would always pop up in my head. Looking back as an adult, a practicing lawyer, a husband, a father, and a member with responsibilities in a church; it's amazing to see he took the time to learn Korean as an adult. Most of us don't want to take the time to learn anything, but he was good at it. By the way, he won the speech competition from earlier. Fast forward a year or two, I walked into my class and I see this very same man in a suit, with a briefcase, notepad, and utensils. He was serious and ready to learn. Clearly, because he had quietly been moving up in classes until he reached the top one! When class began the next thought was "Impressed": I actually remember being so impressed at his professionalism that I remember paying very close attention in class that year. I wanted to be like Mr. Campbell. Which leads me to my next thought/memory of Mr. Campbell.2. Every time I interacted with Mr. Campbell and anyone could tell you this: he was so kind. He was the most gentle soul I had known. There was not a single time you could tell he was upset. I'm not saying that you have to bottle things up to be a good person, but I don't think anything really ever got to him to even bottle anything up. He would always listen to what you're saying, be engaged in your conversation, and respond back with kindness and sincerity. I will miss Mr. Campbell. My deepest condolences to the Campbell family, for the loss of a great man, husband, father, and grandfather. May he rest in peace.

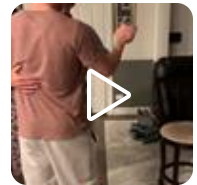

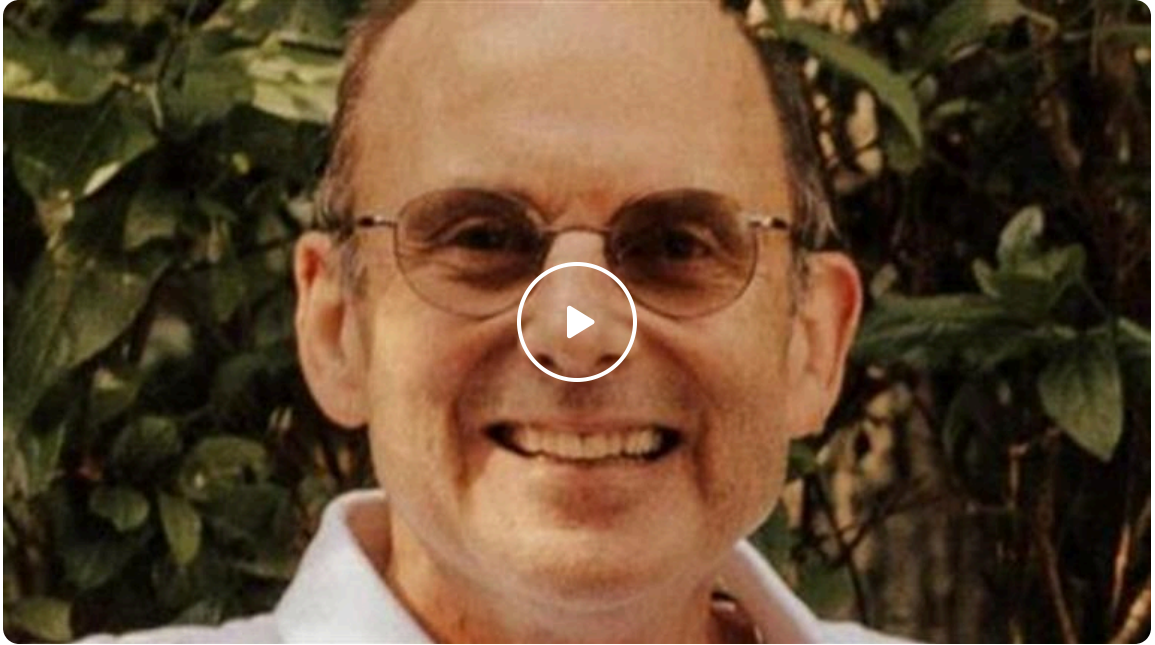

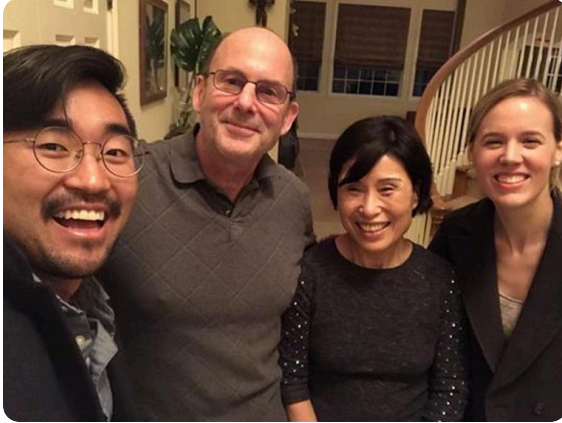
