Doe for 52 years and was the mother of four children, Christopher, Laura, Jessica (married to Brian), and Joshua (married to Karin), and the grandmother to Grace, Matthew, Jacob, Henry, Libby, Hannah, Ava, Caleb, Sarah, James, Kaitlin, and Charlotte. She is survived as well by a brother, Ted, and two sisters, Patti and Diane; Joanie was pre-deceased by a brother, Phil.
