Oliver "Chillie" Smith Wood, III, 76, of Culpeper, died Tuesday, October 8, 2024, at UVA Culpeper Hospital. He was born March 17, 1948, in Charlottesville to the late Frances W and Oliver S. Wood, Jr.

Chillie was an avid Civil War relic hunter in his early years. He also enjoyed collecting coins and canoeing. He was a building inspector for the towns of Culpeper and Herndon and eventually worked as a private inspector. He was a charter member and lifetime member of Reva Volunteer Fire Dept.

He is survived by his wife, Karen Elaine Wood; one son, William Wood (Nichole); two grandchildren, Mason Wood and Reid Wood; two brothers-in-law, Harry Ricketts and Benny Joe Ricketts (Linda); his good friend, who was like a brother, Dennis Cox; and a host of extended family and friends.

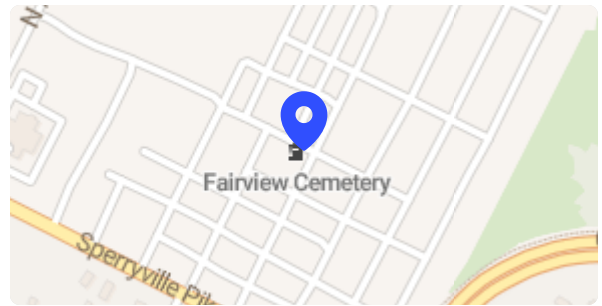

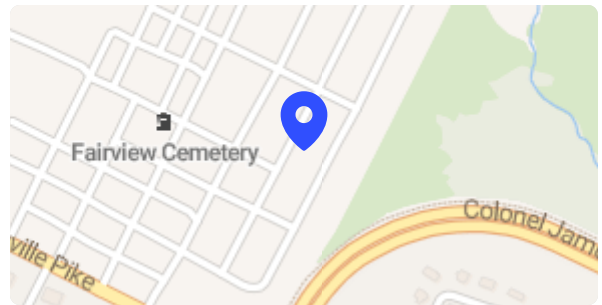
