Stephen Wayne Phillips, Sr., 76, of Rixeyville, died Wednesday, December 4, 2024, at Fauquier Hospital. He was born July 28, 1948, in Decatur, IL to the late Geraldine Christine Phillips and Harold Milton Phillips, Jr.

Stephen was a member of St. Johns Episcopal Church of Decatur, IL, and a veteran of the US Army. He collected guns and coins and enjoyed fishing and especially coaching. 


