# Joanne Anita Singleton

Joanne Anita Singleton (nee Cagle) passed away at her home of 48 years in Castleton, Virginia, on January 2, 2025. She was born to the late James Burton Cagle, Sr., and Nellie Virginia Pflager Cagle on August 23, 1941, in Maryland and grew up in Carmody Hills, Maryland.

Joanne and John (J.B.) met on a blind date and were married on December 6, 1958, in Washington, DC. After living in Arlington, they lived in Vienna, Virginia until they moved to their forever home in Rappahannock County in 1976. She was known to those who loved her as Mom, Mama, or Jo, but her favorite name to answer to was “Nana”. 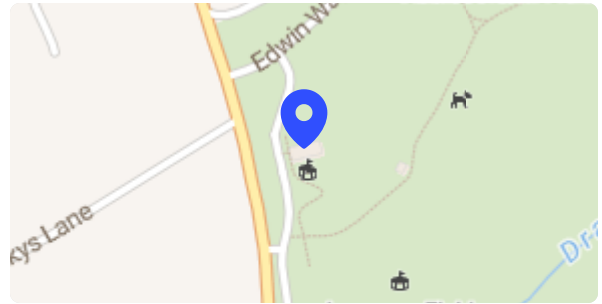
