# Martha Phillips Parrish

**M**artha Phillips Parrish, age 90, passed away on May 20, 2025, at her residence in Culpeper, Virginia. Martha was born on July 13, 1934, in Washington, D.C., and was raised, along with her three younger sisters, in Annandale, Virginia. She graduated from Fairfax High School in 1952, and after marrying her husband Murray, moved to Vienna, Virginia in 1963, where they raised their three children, Deborah, David, and Darryl. 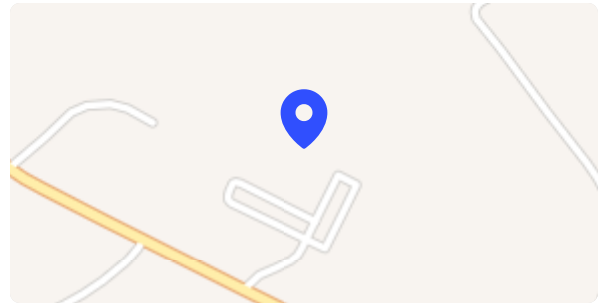
