Joseph John Jankowski, Jr., 77, of Culpeper, passed away May 26, 2025, at his residence. He was born July 13, 1947 to the late Joseph John Jankowski, Sr. and Irene Molnar Jankowski in Toledo, OH.

Joe was a strong and caring man of God. He attended Mountain View Community Church of Culpeper. His wish was for his family and friends to know God's grace and to accept Him as Savoir.
