# John Raymond Carros

**J**ohn Raymond Carros, 97, of Rixeyville, VA passed away Wednesday, September 17, 2025 at Spring Oak in Warrenton. He was born February 18, 1928 to the late Felix and Anna Carros in Binghamton, NY.

He proudly served in the U.S. Army during World War II as a radio repairman, playing a vital role in keeping communications running during a critical time in history. After the war, he attended Cornell University on the GI Bill, where he earned his Electrical Engineering degree.

Following graduation, John began working for the government, and several years later he met his future wife, Marcia. After marrying in 1960, they settled in Rome, NY until John was transferred to Riverside, CA, all the while growing their family. In 1969, the family moved to Fairfax, VA, where they raised their six children. John retired after 38 years with the government. He and his wife moved from Fairfax to Rixeyville, VA in 1998 to enjoy a quieter life away from all the hustle and bustle.

A man who enjoyed tinkering and fixing, he found great joy in small engine and appliance repair. He was always willing to lend a helping hand and get things running again.

In his later years, he enjoyed the simple pleasures of life—watching *The Price Is Right* and *Ice Road Truckers* were among his favorite pastimes.
