She loved to reminisce about her cherished childhood memories. Some of those memories were riding on her dad's milk truck and working many projects with him. Other memories were times with her stay-at-home Mom, day trips and vacations with her mom and dad, and many special times with her grandparents and extended family.

Thankful for her Christian up-brining, Robin accepted the Lord as her Savior as a young girl. She attended Family Community Church (Culpeper Assembly of God) her whole life and was a member. She always showed herself as a Christian and witnessed of God's faithfulness and healing power.

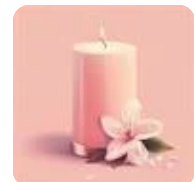
