Ray Eugene Wentz, age 91, passed away Monday, December 1, 2025 at his residence. He was born on January 11, 1934 to the late Jacob Clyde and Hazel Wentz.

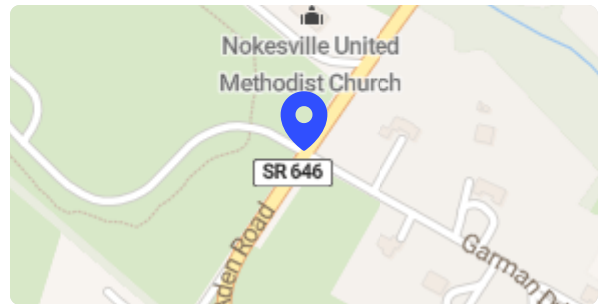

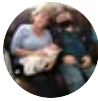
