Leslie Dolores Aylor (Doe), age 91, passed away peacefully on April 24, 2026. She was born at home in Madison on December 8, 1934, to Rufus Aylor and Bessie Brown.

Doe lived a life marked by faith, service, and dedication to her community. She worked for many years at Culpeper National Bank through its many name changes over the years. She was a respected leader who served as president of the Business and Professional Women and held many offices throughout her years of involvement. 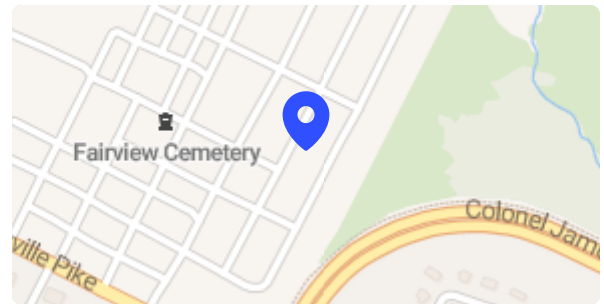
